OPT-IN NOTIFICATION FOR SWANSEY COMMUNITY POWER

The Town of Swansey is pleased to introduce our electricity supply program, Swansey Community Power. Please read on to learn about the program and your options for participation. You can also learn more at a community meeting on April 26th, 2023 at 6:00 pm at Whitcomb Hall located at 17 Main St. in Swansey.

The Town of Swansey has chosen an electricity supplier and negotiated prices for multiple electricity options that are available to our entire community.

Swansey's program starts in June 2023. You may opt in and join Swansey's program at any time, if desired.

If you choose to participate, you can leave the Program at any time in the future, without penalty.

Swansey Community Power is a town-operated group purchasing program that pools the electric use of residents and businesses in order to provide competitively priced electricity options in addition to cleaner electricity options. The Town approved this program in Spring of 2022 and subsequently was approved by the Select Board in Fall 2022.

If you participate in Swansey Community Power, it will change the source and cost of your electricity supply. It will not affect the cost or quality of service for the delivery of electricity from the utility, Eversource.

The table below shows pricing and other information for Swansey's electricity supply options and a comparison to Eversource's current "Default Service".

The Swansey Community Power program cannot guarantee savings for the entire contract term, because Eversource's Default Service rates are not known for the entire contract term. Renewable energy percentages above are rounded to the nearest whole percent.

Please note, Industrial customers (rate class GV) that seek to opt in to Swansey's program may be offered a price other than those shown in the table and that reflect the latest market conditions. In that event, the supplier will ask you to confirm any such price before you are enrolled.

HOW SWANZEY COMMUNITY POWER WORKS

- If you participate in Swanzeý's program, the impact on your electricity bill from Eversource, will be:
 - The Supplier portion of the bill will change to reflect your participation in Swanzeý's Program.
 - Eversource will continue to provide all Delivery Services, including responding to power outages, and Eversource will continue to send you the electricity bill.
 - Customers that receive a discount on their electricity bill through the Electric Assistance Program (EAP) will continue to receive their benefits.
 - Budget billing customers will continue to receive budget billing for the Delivery Services portion of the bill.
 - Customers that receive credits from solar or hydroelectric net metering should visit the Program website or call our dedicated net metering support line to learn more about how your benefits may be affected: SwanzeýCommunityPower.com or 877-877-1670.
- **Pricing:** Program prices apply to service beginning and ending on the days of the month that your meter is read. Program prices include a fee of \$0.001 per kilowatt hour (kWh) for the Town's aggregation consultant. Any applicable taxes will be added by Eversource to your bill. The Town will announce price changes at least 30 days before any such price change takes effect. Product details will always be available at the Town's website for the Program: SwanzeýCommunityPower.com
- **Renewable Energy:** All program options include renewable energy to meet the State of New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS). Swanzeý Standard adds 10% voluntary renewable energy to the RPS. Swanzeý 50% and 100% add voluntary renewable energy to total 50% and 100% renewable energy, respectively. All voluntary renewable energy comes from sources that qualify as NH Class I, the State's designation for new renewable energy located in or imported into New England.
- **Supplier:** The program is served by Direct Energy, PUC license number: DM 15-513.
